Important: Change to Allegion PPAPs — Transitioning to PRISM Platform

Dear Valued Supplier,

Allegion is updating our Production Part Approval Process (PPAP).

To improve transparency, speed, and collaboration between Allegion and our suppliers, we will transition from email and Excel templates to a web-based platform called PRISM. PRISM is the same platform Allegion has been using for over 10 years for our supplier 8Ds and will enable us to improve our PPAP process through real time collaboration, acceptance of PPAP requirements by element throughout the APQP process and documentation of all PPAP activities within PRISM.

Rollout approach

- PRISM will be implemented through a staggered rollout by Allegion site, beginning with Ensenada NPD projects and all Von Duprin PPAPs created on or after Monday, June 15, 2026.
- Security and Ensenada sustaining PPAPs are expected to transition to PRISM 6 – 9 months after the initial rollout, followed by remaining Allegion sites every 3 – 6 months.
- During the transition period, suppliers supporting multiple Allegion sites may be required to use both PPAP processes.

Supplier actions and expectations

- Watch for an invitation from PRISM indicating that a new PRISM PPAP has been assigned. Upon receipt, please register the appropriate users who will submit and manage PPAPs for your organization.
- Ensure designated users have reliable internet access and a modern web browser.
- Continue submitting PPAPs using Allegion's current method for Allegion sites that have not yet transitioned to PRISM until you are notification.

Training and support

- Training will be provided as needed (live sessions, recorded materials) and will also be available on-demand on the Allegion Supplier Portal.

- We will update our supplier as additional Allegion sites begin using PRISM for their PPAPs.
